1. SALE VENUE

2. ENTRY DETAILS

- a) Please complete your entries via your Tattersalls Online Account (www.tattersalls.com), where the Terms and Conditions are available to download. Tattersalls must receive catalogue entries no later than 10.00 a.m. on **Tuesday 7th April**, subject to selection and confirmation.
- b) Final entries will be accepted up to 09.00 a.m. on **Monday 13th April**, subject to selection and confirmation.
- c) Tattersalls check entry details on vendors' information only. They are believed to be correct, but the responsibility is entirely the Vendors. Tattersalls are in no way responsible for any misdescription.

3. FEES & COMMISSION (See Condition of Sale 3)

- a) The entry fee for this Sale will be **£800** for each Lot catalogued. This includes charges for compilation of Sales details and printing. The minimum selling price at this Sale is **£3,000** (See Condition of Sale 3.1).
- b) Lots withdrawn from this Sale without a veterinary certificate to Tattersalls' satisfaction after 10.00 a.m. on **Tuesday 7th April** will incur a withdrawal fee of **£500** (See Condition of Sale 3.4).
- c) Veterinary certificates must be received by Tattersalls within 28 days after the last day of the Sale.
- d) Commission (See Condition of Sale 3.2).
- e) Fees and Commission are subject to VAT or equivalent where applicable (See Condition of Sale 3.9).
- f) For each Lot sold at Tattersalls Sales, the Vendor will pay £3, which Tattersalls will deduct from the sales proceeds to support the Retraining of Racehorses Charity (See Tattersalls Condition of Sale 22.3).

4. PEDIGREE PROOFS

- a) You will receive email notification when your pedigree proofs are available to view on your Tattersalls Online Account. Vendors are reminded that they alone are responsible for the accuracy of their catalogue details, and they are advised to check these proofs with care.
- b) No pedigree amendments can be made for this Sale, other than to notify us of any changes to the horse details, which must be received immediately.
- c) Proofs are available to you the Consignor and therefore, where there are other owners you should send a copy of the proof to them for this purpose.
- d) Any requested pedigree proof amendments will only be made if in line with Tattersalls and SITA/ICSC criteria.
- e) Deadline for initial catalogue entries 10.00 a.m. on **Tuesday 7th April**.
- f) Print deadline for final entries 10.00 a.m. on **Monday 13th April**.

5. CATALOGUING

- a) Lots will be catalogued alphabetically by the name of the dam – **2026 Starting Letter = F**.

6. CATALOGUE DISTRIBUTION

- a) Catalogues are automatically distributed to the address of the signee on the Sale Entry Form. If further catalogues are required, please provide Tattersalls with the relevant name, address, email, and telephone number.

7. VENDOR OWNERSHIP (See Condition of Sale 9.12)

- a) Please refer to this Condition to see what is required where there has been any change in the ownership of a Lot between the date of the Sale Entry Form and the time at which the Lot is put up for auction.

8. REGISTRATION COSTS

- a) Where costs are incurred by a Purchaser in registering a Lot as catalogued or in obtaining all required registration papers for a Lot, these costs will be the responsibility of the Vendor. Vendors of Lots coming from overseas must apply to their Stud Book Authority for export certificates to be sent to Weatherbys.

9. INSURANCE (See Condition of Sale 8)

- a) We strongly recommend that insurance cover is arranged against mortality and theft.

10. HEALTH DOCUMENTATION

Documentation requirements for this Sale are available on the Sale Documentation Notice and listed on your Tattersalls Online Account. Template certificates for completion by your vet are available to download from the Tattersalls Cheltenham website, www.tattersallscheltenham.com/information/documentation

11. ARRIVALS

- a) The Control Office will be open for arrivals from 6.00 p.m. on **Monday 13th April**. For further details contact Tattersalls Sales Manager Shirley Anderson-Jolag on +44 (0) 7388 382511.
- b) Do not unload your entries from their horsebox until their passport has been checked and cleared by the Control Office.
- c) There is a loading area in the Charles Turner Yard which may not suit all vehicles, and one in the Main Racing Yard. We recommend use of these loading bays.

12. VETERINARY EXAMINATION (See Conditions of Sale 9)

- a) Unless otherwise stated in the catalogue or announced by the auctioneers at the time of Sale, all horses will be sold with a pre-sale veterinary certificate.
- b) Please book a veterinary examination upon arrival directly with Jamie Codd on +353 (87) 787 0655
- c) The veterinary examination will take place in Row G of the Charles Turner Yard.
- d) Vendors are reminded that they or their representative, who present the horse to the panel for veterinary examination, should be fully aware of any relevant information pertaining to the Lot.

13. PRESENTATION OF LOTS

- a) To ensure that Lots realise their full potential, those entered in the Sale should be available to view from 2.00 p.m. on **Wednesday 15th April** and 8.00 a.m. on **Thursday 16th April**, until the end of the day's Sale or until the horse is sold.
- b) All horses must be presented at all times, whether loading, unloading, in the stables, and sale ring in either a bridle or chifney and not on any account a head collar.
- c) Vendors should take their Lots to the pre-parade ring as soon as they are summoned by Tattersalls staff and at least half an hour before they are due to enter the sale ring.

14. SALES PROCEDURE

- a) Vendors and their staff are requested to always observe good Health and Safety practices.
- b) Vendors are reminded that only hay and straw are provided; the Vendor must supply other feed.
- c) Hip stickers must be collected from the Control Office on arrival. These should be worn when Lots are being shown and when presented for sale.
- d) Vendors are requested to leave head-collars and rugs on all sold Lots.
- e) All horses are requested to be removed from the stables on their day of Sale and no later than 12.00 p.m. (noon) on the following day of the Sale.
- f) Vendors of any Lot displaying signs of suspected ringworm, including visible skin lesions, must provide a negative skin scraping certificate in advance of arrival at Tattersalls' premises. Please refer to Sales Documentation Notice.

15. BLOOD TESTING (PROSCRIBED DRUGS AND PIROPLASMOSIS)

- a) Blood testing is available to all Lots at the option of purchasers as described under Condition of Sale 22 (Non-Steroidal-Anti-Inflammatories; Corticosteroids; Clenbuterol) and Condition of Sale 23 (Piroplasmosis).

16. IMPORT DOCKET SCHEME

- a) Tattersalls GB has a special agreement with H.M. Revenue & Customs (HMRC) to use the "Docket Scheme" for horses being imported for sale at Tattersalls Cheltenham.
- b) The Docket Scheme allows non-UK vendors to send their horses to the sales without having to pay import VAT at the point of entry. It also removes the requirement on the vendor having to register for VAT in the UK. The Docket Scheme may only be used by vendors for horses based outside of GB and Northern Ireland.
- c) Unsold lots will need to be exported back out of the UK for the import VAT to be zero rated.

17. ACCOMMODATION
